CR14-1070 A resolution levying upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the year 2014, to be collected in 2015, for purposes authorized by law.

Approves the annual City Property Tax Mill Levy for the year 2014 to be collected in 2015. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 12-18-14.

CR14-1082 A resolution levying upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the year 2014 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

Approves the annual tax levy upon all taxable property within the City for the year 2014 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 12-18-14.

CR14-1083 A resolution levying taxes for the year 2014 upon all taxable property within special districts within the City and County of Denver for purposes authorized by law for special districts.

Approves the annual tax levy upon all taxable property within special districts within the City for the year 2014 for purposes authorized by law for special districts. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 12-18-14.

CB14-1053 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Design-Build Contract Fire Station 35 between the City and County of Denver and PCL Construction Services, Inc. related to design and construction of Fire Station 35 at Denver International Airport.

Approves a contract with PCL Construction Services, Inc. for \$8.5 million through 6-30-16 for the full design and construction of the new Fire Station 35 at Denver International Airport (201314429). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill on consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1054 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fifth Amendment to Permit Agreement for Multi - purpose Permit - Ref. No. 300 between the City and County of Denver and Park Creek Metropolitan District for general construction traffic access, ingress, and egress at the former Stapleton site.

Approves an amendment to the Multi-Purpose License (Multi-Purpose Permit Ref. 300) to the Park Creek Metropolitan District by extending the license by three years four months for a new expiration date of 5-15-18 and to allow the developer to utilize airport property for construction activities to facilitate the development at Stapleton for the areas south of Smith Road (AC13010(5)). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-14. The Committee approved filing this bill on consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1055 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fourth Amendment to Permit Agreement for the use of existing utilities, Ref. No. 400 between the City and County of Denver and Park Creek Metropolitan District at the former Stapleton site.

Approves an amendment to the Multi-Purpose License (Multi-Purpose Permit Ref. 400) to the Park Creek Metropolitan District by extending the license by three years four months for a new expiration date of 5-15-18 to allow the developer to utilize airport property for construction activities to facilitate the development at Stapleton for the areas south of Smith Road (AC34006(4)). The last regularly scheduled

Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-14. The Committee approved filing this bill on consent on 12-11-14.

Finance & Services

CB14-1024 A bill for an ordinance approving the exchange of City-owned land at 1201 North Perry Street to allow for the relocation of an alley in the development of 1209 North Perry.

Approves the exchange of 2,300 square feet of City-owned land at 1201 North Perry for 2,210 square feet of privately-owned land (known as a portion of the address of 1209 North Perry) to allow for the relocation of an alley in the development of 1209 North Perry in Council District 1. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1049 A bill for an ordinance authorizing the transfer of accrued investment earnings from the 1989 Colorado Convention Center Replacement Fund to the Colorado Convention Center Capital Maintenance Fund.

Transfers \$210,773 in accrued investment earnings from the 1989 Colorado Convention Center Replacement Fund (38095) to the Capital Improvement Fund (34080) for Convention Center capital maintenance. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

Neighborhoods & Planning

CB14-1047 A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification for 1555 and 1597 Stuart Street.

Rezones property at 1555 and 1597 Stuart Street from Former Chapter 59 PUD #559 (Planned Unit Development #559) to C-MX-3 (Commercial, Mixed Use, 3 stories) in Council District 1. A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS AFTER PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-10-14.

CB14-1075 A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification of 4625 West 50th Avenue and 5030 Vrain Street.

Rezones property located at 4625 West 50th Avenue and 5030 Vrain Street from PUD #273 (Planned Unit Development #273) to PUD #G11 (Planned Unit Development #G11) in Council District 1. A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS AFTER PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-10-14.

CB14-1076 A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification of certain portions of vacated alleys in the Cherry Creek North area, roughly bounded by 1st Avenue, 3rd Avenue, University and Steele Street.

Corrects the legal description of the legislative map amendment that rezoned

property from C-CCN (Urban Center, Cherry Creek North), PUD (Planned Unit Development), or C-MU-10 (Urban Center, Mixed Use, 10 stories) with waivers and conditions to proposed zone districts C-CCN-4 (4 stories), C-CCN-5 (5 stories), C-CCN-7 (7 stories), or C-CCN-8 (8 stories) in Council District 10. A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS AFTER PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-11-14.

Safety & Well-being

CB14-0973 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Mental Health Center of Denver to provide support services to the chronically homeless in Denver

Amends a contract with the Mental Health Center of Denver to add \$830,000 for a new total of \$1.66 million to provide housing and treatment services for 75 chronically homeless individuals with mental health and sometimes co-occurring substance use disorders (SOCSV-2013-14438-02). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-13-14.

CB14-0993 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and The Colorado Coalition for the Homeless to provide housing placement and treatment services to homeless adults in Denver.

Amends a contract with The Colorado Coalition for the Homeless to extend the term through 12-31-15 and add \$325,000 for a new total of \$650,000 to provide housing placement and treatment services for 60 chronically homeless adults in Denver (SOCSV-2013-14439-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-9-14.

CB14-1000 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Volunteers of America Colorado Branch to provide on-call emergency shelter to Denver's homeless.

Amends a contract with Volunteers of America Colorado Branch to add \$416,000 for a new total of \$832,000, and extend the term one year through 12-31-15 to provide housing for families and single women when all of the City's emergency shelter beds are full, and to add Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) language (2013-14480-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-26-14.

CB14-1039 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and The Salvation Army to oversee emergency shelter operations for homeless men.

Amends a contract with The Salvation Army to add an additional \$380,000 for a new total of \$710,000 and extend the term through 12-31-15 to provide emergency shelter for up to 200 homeless men per night at the Crossroads Shelter in Council District 9 (SOCSV-2013-14454-02). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1077 A bill for an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the State of Colorado to award funding for the "Community Services Block Grant FY15-16" program.

Appropriates \$506,259.50, which is 50% of the grant award for the 2015-2016 Community Services Block Grant based on a Letter of Intent provided by the Colorado Department of Local Affairs, to continue essential services to addressing poverty and homelessness. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1085 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fifth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Northeast Denver Housing Center, Inc., to modify the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement.

Amends an existing contract with Northeast Denver Housing Center, Inc. by increasing the subordination level on a City loan from \$500,000 to \$700,000 due to refinance of its debt in order to make substantial repairs to the roof, common areas, and interiors (GE7Y034). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1086 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Renaissance Housing Development Corporation to modify the terms of the Loan Agreement.

Amends a contract with Renaissance Housing Development Corporation (Colorado Coalition for the Homeless) to increase the City's subordination amount from \$15 million to \$17.5 million in order to match the increase in the first loan with US Bank (OEDEV-201416398-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-12-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-11-14.

CB14-1013 A bill for an ordinance making rescissions in the General Fund and reappropriations in the Capital Improvement and Capital Maintenance Fund.

Approves the rescission and transfer of \$900,000 from Department of Parks and Recreation Operating Budget to the Capital Improvement Fund (33069) to be appropriated for the construction of the Central Denver Recreation Center. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-2-14.

CB14-1014 A bill for an ordinance making appropriations and rescissions in the General Contingency Fund; making a transfer from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund; and making appropriations in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund.

Approves a supplemental appropriation of \$3.2 million from the General Fund 2014 Contingency Fund (utilizing one-time Retail Marijuana Special Sales Tax) and approves transfers to the Capital Improvement Fund (33069) for expenditures on the Central Denver Recreation Center. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-2-14.

CB14-1017 A bill for an ordinance establishing a "Social Impact Bond" fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures from such fund.

Approves the creation of a new fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund for Social Impact Bonds to provide a multi-year reserve to make performance-based payments to contractors providing housing and case management for chronically homeless individuals. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1019 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Chandler Asset Management to maintain advisory and investment management services.

Approves a \$1.425 million contract with Chandler Asset Management for investment advisory and management services through 12-31-19 (FINAN-201417767-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1023 A bill for an Ordinance approving a proposed Lease Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Urban Gardens to use city property for three community gardens.

Approves a five-year lease agreement (through 09-30-18) with Denver Urban Gardens for three community gardens at 201 Grant, 1350 East Florida, and 2200 Emerson streets for \$1 annually each (FINAN-201313505-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The

Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1030 A bill for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 699, Series of 2014, the annual appropriating ordinance, to increase the Denver Preschool Program appropriation based on funds that will be generated from the passing of the November 4, 2014, 2A ballot measure.

Amends the 2015 Long Bill (Council Bill No. CB14-0944) to appropriate an additional \$3.8 million to fund the Denver Preschool Program. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1032 A bill for an ordinance making rescissions of budget balances to close out the "Community Corrections FY13-14" grant, rescind the budget balance and transfer the cash balance in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund to the General Fund.

Closes the "Community Corrections Fiscal Year 13-14" grant in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, rescinds the budget balance of \$261,529.46, and transfers the cash balance of \$105,025.90 to the General Fund. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1037 A bill for an ordinance approving the First Amendment to Lease Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Subway Real Estate, L.L.C. to amend the terms of the lease for the Justice Center Garage.

Reduces the rent through the remaining term of the lease with Subway Real Estate for the Justice Center Garage from \$2,023 a month to \$1,600 a month (201101016-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1043 A bill for an ordinance concerning the Airport System of the City and County of Denver; authorizing the City and County of Denver, Colorado, for and on behalf of its Department of Aviation, to enter into an Installment Purchase Agreement and to incur a loan from Banc of America Public Capital Corp in a maximum principal amount of \$ 1,809,843.91 for the purpose of acquiring, installing and financing equipment for the Airport System; authorizing the repayment of such loan; ratifying action previously taken; and providing for other matters relating thereto.

Authorizes the Manager of Finance to provide financing through a capital lease purchase transaction on behalf of the Department of Aviation for new technology services equipment for Denver International Airport in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,809,844 (PLANE-201419198-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1044 A bill for an ordinance approving a Purchase and Sale Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Manoah, LLC for 405 South Platte River Drive.

Approves a purchase and sale agreement with Manoah, LLC for land and improvements at 405 South Platte River Drive for \$2.325 million for a facility offering invention services in Council District 7. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-2-14.

CB14-1045 A bill for an ordinance creating a Fund Number in the Grant/Other Capital Projects Fund for the Denver Road Home Improvements project and the funding therefor.

Establishes a new capital grant fund (38402) and supporting appropriation in the amount of \$2.266 million per a grant agreement with the Denver Rescue Mission for reimbursement of Lawrence Street Community Center project costs. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-2-14.

Infrastructure & Culture

CB14-0941 A bill for an ordinance granting a certificate of designation to the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. to operate a waste to energy system at the Denver Zoo

Grants a certificate of designation to the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. to operate its waste to energy system at the Denver Zoo. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-3-14.

CB14-0981 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Purchase Order between the City and County of Denver and Barbizon Light of the Rockies, Inc., to replace the lighting system in the Ellie Caulkins Opera House

Approves a \$799,360 purchase order with Barbizon Light of the Rockies, Inc. to replace the strand lighting system in the Ellie Caulkins Opera House (Requisition #54967). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1020 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT), relating to the "FASTER Safety SH 30 Havana" project and the funding therefor.

Approves an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Colorado's Department of Transportation to receive and expend \$2,180,990 in federal funds to complete the environmental and design work and related tasks for the pedestrian safety improvement connections on State Highway 30 at Hampden & Havana from Dayton to Dartmouth (PWADM – 201419126). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

CB14-1048 A bill for an ordinance vacating a triangular parcel of right-of-way at the intersection of East 20th Avenue, Glenarm Place and 20th Street, without reservations.

Vacates land at the intersection at 2044 Glenarm Place, East 20th Avenue, Glenarm Place, and 20th Street in Council District 8. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.

Safety & Well-being

CB14-0678 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed loan agreement between the City and County of Denver and Ruby Hill Residences LLLP, for a HOME loan to construct an affordable new apartment community.

Approves a 40-year \$875,000 HOME loan to Ruby Hill Residences, LLP for the development of a 114-unit affordable apartment community of 1 and 2 bedroom units on a 3-acre site at 1400 W. Mississippi, 1101 S. Osage, and 1100 S. Pecos in Council District 7. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 8-21-14.

CB14-0950 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Sixth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Xerox State & Local Solutions, Inc., to extend the term of the contract and provide additional compensation for the Automated Photo Red Light Program.

Amends the contract with Xerox State and Local Solutions to add \$81,000, for a new total of \$1,104,272, and extend it for 6 months, through 6-30-15, to continue the Automated Photo Red Light Program during the request for proposal process (CE-01061-06). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 11-25-14.

CB14-0951 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Sixth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Xerox State & Local Solutions, Inc., to extend the term of the contract and provide additional compensation for the Photo Speed Enforcement Program.

Amends the contract with Xerox State and Local Solutions to add \$708,000, for a new total of \$9,313,849, and extend it for 6 months, through 6-30-15, to continue the Photo Speed Enforcement Program during the request for proposal process (CE-81107-06). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 11-25-14.

Technology & Governance

CB14-0969 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement by and between the City and County of Denver and EffectiveUI, Inc., to increase the compensation and extend the term of the contract.

Extends the contract with Effective UI two years to 12-31-17 and adds \$1.5 million for a new total of \$ 1.999 million to continue design, implementation and on-going

upgrade of the City's technology services to constituents using desktop or mobile devices (201314328). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 12-2-14.

CB14-0994 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement by and between the City and County of Denver and Syscon Justice Systems, Inc., to extend the term of the contract for on-call services.

Approves a no-cost extension of the contract with Syscon Justice Systems for three years through 12-31-17 for on-call professional services as needed for the Jail Management System (JMS) used by the Denver Sheriff's Department (201103793-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-20-14.

CB14-1059 A bill for an Ordinance approving the 2015 Eco Pass Agreement with the Regional Transportation District (RTD) to provide discounted Eco pass decals for city employees to utilize bus and train services with funding approved through the Alternative Transportation Special Revenue Fund.

Approves the 2015 Eco Pass Agreement with The Regional Transportation District (RTD) to provide Eco pass decals to eligible City employees for use of RTD's bus and train services with funding approved through the Alternative Transportation Special Revenue Fund. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-5-15. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-4-14.
