

PROCLAMATION NO. 20-1005 RECOGNIZING THE EXTRAORDINARY CAREER AND RETIREMENT OF STEVE KURTZ

WHEREAS, Denver Parks and Recreation supports the physical and mental health of resident by maintaining over 250 parks and providing activities in over 30 recreation centers accessible to people of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, for over 20 years, Steve Kurtz helped Denver Parks and Recreation fulfill its mission to provide dynamic, innovative programs and safe beautiful spaces to Denver residents; and

WHEREAS, Steve was an integral part of the Denver Golf team, making sure guests enjoyed their time at the course and that operations ran smoothly; and

WHEREAS, Steve's level-headed approach to everything made him a reliable teammate who was calm and collected no matter what; and

WHEREAS, Steve greeted more than 75,000 guests in his 21 years with Denver Golf!

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Denver City Council recognizes and honors the dedicated service of Steve Kurtz to the residents of the City and County of Denver.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to Steve Kurtz.
