Executive Summary

An ordinance to authorize Public Works to obtain forty-two (42) Peterbilt Cab and Chassis financed through a companion capital lease purchase agreement with Chase Equipment Finance, Inc.

The City and County of Denver is seeking to purchase obtain forty-two (42) Peterbilt Cab and Chassis from RUSH TRUCK CENTERS OF COLORADO, INC. The proposed agreement is a zero dollar agreement that will allow the City to obtain the equipment and a companion agreement with Chase Equipment Finance, Inc., who is the financier. The cost of the equipment is \$10,601,433.24.

This purchase is part of a "catch-up" effort to address an aging fleet to reduce the cost of maintaining the aged fleet.

Because the City's Charter requires Council approval of any agreement in excess of \$500,000 and this agreement is a companion to the financing agreement, this ordinance is requested.
