**A RESOLUTION**

**Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services concerning the “Unaccompanied Refugee Minor” program and the funding therefor.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed amended Grant Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services Office of Local Affairs, for the “Unaccompanied Refugee Minor” program, which is identified as Grant Number 18 IHGA 109600, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 201951744, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the United States of America to the City pursuant to and under the amended Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 13000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Denver Human Services, is as follows:

The foregoing amendment increases the current grant authorization from \$377,574 to \$1,065,928. Authorization for expenditures of said funds will cover the period from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020.
