**A BILL**

**For an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, relating to the “Highline Canal at Mississippi & Parker” project and the funding therefor.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement under CFDA No. 20.205, between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of Intergovernmental Agreement available in the office and on the webpage of City Council, and to be filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 17-0144, is hereby approved.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said project is as follows:

Authorization for expenditure of said funds following the execution of said contract will cover the period from June 1, 2017 to June 1, 2022. There is a local match of \$800,400.
