Executive Summary

First delivered in 2022 post-pandemic in a collaborative effort between the city and The Denver Foundation, Nonprofit Technical Assistance grants are designed to strengthen nonprofit organizations serving historically marginalized or underserved communities.

Delivered in concert with Community Mini-Grants, this initiative will empower and enhance support to Denver's least advantaged residents by strengthening the nonprofits dedicated to serving them. Grants to small nonprofits will range from \$500 - \$20,000.

Grants will be considered for organizations that meet the below criteria:

- Entities that are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization or have a 501(c)(3) fiscal sponsor.
- Organizations that are based, or provide services or organize, in vulnerable neighborhoods as identified by DEDO's division of Neighborhood Equity & Stabilization (NEST)
- All work must be completed by November 29, 2024.
- For the application, organizations must upload a scope of work prepared with their consultant as part of the application process.

Technical Assistance grants are typically awarded for

- Strategic and operational planning
- Fund development
- Governance and board development
- Communications, information management
- Policy and advocacy work
- Evaluation tool development
- Resident engagement, community organizing.
- Inclusiveness and racial equity

In its 2022-23 iteration, the Nonprofit Technical Assistance Grants delivered \$ 385,950 to 28 organizations.
