THIRD AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE FUNDING, IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAMS INVOLVING POLICE OFFICERS IN SCHOOLS

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL

AGREEMENT ("Third Amendment") dated as hereinafter set forth on the City's signature page, is made by and between the **CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER**, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado ("City" or "Police Department") and **SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE** ("DPS", "School District" or "District"), collectively the "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement dated February 21, 2013 and amended the Intergovernmental Agreement on December 11, 2013 and September 24, 2014 ("IGA") to provide for partnership programs involving fifteen (15) police officers ("School Resource Officers" or "SRO") assigned by the Police Department to DPS middle schools and high schools; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the IGA to increase the compensation by DPS to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and obligations herein set forth, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Article 6(a) of the Agreement entitled "<u>REIMBURSEMENT BY SCHOOL</u> <u>DISTRICT</u>" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "6. a. School District's Cost of SRO Partnership/Invoicing and Payments.

 The total projected cost of the High School/Middle School SRO Partnership for the 2015-2016 school year depicted on Exhibit A-3 is \$1,575,316.00.

 Except as provided herein, from August 24, 2015 through June 3, 2016,

 DPS agrees to pay, and the City agrees to accept, as full and complete compensation to the City for the SRO Partnership, a fixed cost of Six

 Hundred Forty Five Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Dollars and Zero

 Cents (\$645,880.00) payable on a pro-rated monthly basis during the term hereof. Invoices for DPS's portion of the cost sharing arrangement are due

and payable in full upon receipt. Except as provided in herein for summer school and non school hours, the total compensation to the City through June 3, 2016 shall be **Two Million Five Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$2,567,954.00).**"

2. Except as herein amended, the Intergovernmental Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every particular.
