6 **For an Ordinance approving a proposed purchase by the City and County of**
7 **Denver ("City) of insurance coverage from: Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of**
8 **Colorado; United Health Care Insurance Company; Denver Health Medical Plan,**
9 **Inc.; Delta Dental of Colorado; Standard Insurance Company of Colorado, Inc.;**
10 **Vision Service Plan Insurance Company.**

12 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 18-5(c), Denver Revised Municipal Code
13 ("D.R.M.C."), the Office of Human Resources Director of Personnel has consulted with the
14 employee health insurance committee and recommends to City Council the following
15 employee benefit changes to the insurance policies and agreements between the City and
16 entities set forth below.

17 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 18-5(c), D.R.M.C., City Council may accept, reject or
18 modify any benefit recommendations made by the Director.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**
20 **OF DENVER:**

21 **Section 1.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from **Kaiser**
22 **Foundation Health Plan of Colorado**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the 2018
23 Rate Sheets and plan descriptions presented at Committee attached hereto, is hereby approved.

24 **Section 2.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from **United Health**
25 **Care Insurance Company**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the 2018 Rate Sheets
26 and plan descriptions presented at Committee attached hereto, is hereby approved.

27 **Section 3.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from **Denver Health**
28 **Medical Plan, Inc.**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the 2018 Rate Sheets and
29 plan descriptions presented at Committee attached hereto, is hereby approved.

30 **Section 4.** The proposed purchase of dental insurance coverage by the City from **Delta**
31 **Dental of Colorado**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the 2018 Rate Sheets and
32 plan descriptions presented at Committee attached hereto, is hereby approved.

33 **Section 5.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage for basic life, accidental death
34 and dismemberment, and long term disability insurance by the City from **Standard Insurance**
35 **Company of Colorado, Inc.**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the 2018 Rate
36 Sheets and plan descriptions presented at Committee attached hereto, is hereby approved.

1 **Section 6.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage for supplemental vision
 2 insurance by the City from **Vision Service Plan Insurance Company**, in the words and figures
 3 contained and set forth in the 2018 Rate Sheets and plan descriptions presented at Committee
 4 attached hereto, is hereby approved.

5 **Section 7.** The Office of Human Resources Director of Personnel, and the Human Resources
 6 Director of the Denver Police Department are hereby authorized to perform all of the duties and
 7 undertake all of the responsibilities needed to effectuate the insurance policies and agreements
 8 between the City and entities set forth above in this ordinance, as contemplated by and consistent
 9 with this ordinance.
