A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Transportation concerning the “Impaired Driving Enforcement and Education” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed amended Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Transportation for the “Impaired Driving Enforcement and Education” program, which is identified as Grant Number 24-HTS-ZL-00191-M0003, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202581279-02, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Transportation to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No.12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, is as follows:

The foregoing amendment of \$224,424 increases the current grant authorization from \$381,060.30 to \$605,484.30. Expenditures of said funds are authorized from October 01, 2023, through September 30, 2026.

Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.

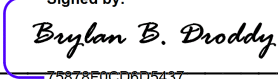
