Attach executive summary if more space needed:  In 2021, City Council approved the issuance and sale of an amount not to exceed \$15,525,000 of the City and County of Denver, Colorado Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for The Rose on Colfax. Owned and operated by Mercy Housing, The Rose on Colfax was constructed and opened in early 2024, bringing 82 affordable housing units and a childcare facility to the East Colfax neighborhood. Mercy Housing has approached the city to refinance its permanent loan with a new lender, and as a result, they must go through the administrative process of reissuing a portion of their original bonds from 2021. This action does not require new private activity bond capacity, nor does it affect the city's credit or financing capacity.
