This contract procures multiple essential services for the City and County of Denver, including:

- 911 emergency services
- Analog lines (elevator and parking lot emergency phones)
- Internet connectivity
- DDOS-(distributed denial of service)
- Interconnectivity between City buildings
- SIP (Session Initiation Protocol)
- Long distance

Current State

- 200 hardwired city site connections & 911 services
 - A switch from the current provider will potentially require significant capital costs and transition time.
 - Provider continuity is desired as resource planning proceeds with an eye to future procurement
- 2 year amendment is being requested to maintain current service levels

Planning Forward

- Publish an RFP early in 2020
- Expected award and replacement contract execution in 2020-2021
