A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Treasury concerning the “Social Impact Partnerships to Pay for Results Act (SIPPRA)” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the SIPPRA is a performance-based grant, with a maximal award amount of \$5,512,000; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA 21.017, between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Treasury, for the “Social Impact Partnerships to Pay for Results Act (SIPPRA)” program, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202160100, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States Department of Treasury to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 16000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Housing Stability, is as follows:

2 terms of the Grant Agreement. Expenditures of said funds are authorized from April 29, 2022 to April
3 28, 2029, as available.

5 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
6 to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.
