This contract will continue to provide the DEN Noise Office access to PASSUR, Aerospace, Inc.'s EnvironmentalVue and PublicVue aircraft noise monitoring software and provide NextGen flight track radar data, as well as provide associated technical support and maintenance. DEN is required to maintain a functioning aircraft noise monitoring system per the terms of the 1988 Denver/Adams County Intergovernmental Agreement on a New Airport.

PASSUR Aerospace Inc. and their suite of ARiVA Symphony software products will assist the DEN Noise Office with the proactive monitoring of flight operations, aircraft noise and community engagement.

EnvironmentalVue is used by the DEN Noise Office to monitor, analyze, and report on DEN aircraft operations and their associated noise impacts. PublicVue is companion software that provides a web portal for the public to view and familiarize themselves with the DEN airspace and air traffic in their vicinity, and to register noise complaints.

DEN also intends to replace all 26 noise monitoring terminals in the first year of this contract, which are approaching the end of life.

ARiVA Symphony software is utilized at more than 60 airports worldwide.
