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BACKGROUND

- DEN maintains 76 wells
- No DEN wells are currently producing (all are “shut in”)
- DEN contractors monitor/maintain wells on a daily basis, providing regular maintenance, and responding to a potential leak or spill
- These services are critical for safety, responsible environmental stewardship, and compliance with all federal and state regulatory requirements
- In addition to safety and environmental risks, failure to comply with our regulatory obligations can result in hearings and fines from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC), Colorado Department of Health and the Environment (CDPHE)
- These contracts DO NOT enable O&G production at DEN

ORDINANCE REQUESTS

- Bohler Well Services, LLC
 - On-call Workover Rig Contract
 - Three years and two months, plus two one-year extensions
 - Max contract value: \$1,300,000.00

- ATP Oilfield Services
 - On-call Roustabout Services Contract
 - Three years, plus two one-year extensions
 - Max contract value: \$2,500,000.00

BOEHLER WELL SERVICES, LLC



- Required regulatory maintenance services
- Below-ground infrastructure (“workover rig”)
- Includes:
 - Personnel / crews
 - Pumps
 - Tanks
 - Blow-out preventers
 - Auxiliary equipment and miscellaneous other services and supplies

ATP OILFIELD SERVICES



- Required regulatory services for monitoring, maintaining and replacing equipment on DEN's oil and gas wells
- “Roustabout services” include above-ground facilities, gas lines and tanks
- Remediation services in the event of a spill or leak
