Rachel Neumann BIO

Rachel Neumann has lived in the Lowry neighborhood since 2004, when she and her husband moved from LoDo to their new home in the Northwest Neighborhood. Today, her oldest child attends Lowry Elementary School, where Rachel is involved in a number of classroom activities as well as the PTO, and her two younger children are enrolled in the school for the upcoming school year.

Rachel is a communications consultant to a variety of businesses and organizations, spanning travel and hospitality to financial services to nonprofits and start-ups. In her career, she has developed PR strategies, led media relations and community outreach campaigns, written and produced promotional materials and websites, and counseled clients and executives in crisis situations.

Before she went out on her own as a consultant, Rachel was the director of communications for Exclusive Resorts, a luxury destination club, and prior to that, she was the national communications director for MDC Holdings, Inc. / Richmond American Homes. In that capacity, she was responsible for developing consistent messaging both inside and outside the company during a time of rapid growth, handling all media inquiries, and assisting executives with the execution of the company's charitable commitments both locally and in its markets around the country. Her background also includes communications work and publicity for medical companies Merck, Pfizer and Amgen as an account supervisor for Ogilvy Public Relations Worldwide.
