Evaluation Criteria



Plan 2000 sets forth ten (10) components for consideration when evaluating proposed land use changes; Six are applicable and none demonstrate compliance with Plan Strategies



Blueprint Denver has not been applied correctly for this property; this obliterates the intent behind Areas of Stability, which comprises much of the property



Fails to justify consideration for use of a General Development Plan or, more effectively, the application of a PUD Zone District



Irrevocably changes the character of the area, specific to the existing low-density, single-story residential neighborhood; adds an unknown and yet significant number of traffic trips


