5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

Security Design/Build Contract, GE74036, will be used to assist the Airport Security Department in design and construction of security Capital Improvement Projects (CIP). In the first three years of the contract the focus was primarily on the installation and construction of a digital CCTV camera system paid for by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) through DHS grant dollars. In addition to the digital CCTV camera system for the TSA, Denver International Airport's (DIA's) analog CCTV system has been designed and constructed to the new digital format. Finally, the contract has focused on designing and constructing the infrastructure for access control biometrics and a "pilot" perimeter security system to test and evaluate technologies for future installation on the bigger perimeter of DIA.

This three year contract amendment/extension will assist the Airport Security Department in completing some of the CIP projects already in progress and start new CIP projects.
