**A BILL**

**For an ordinance approving the issuance of a series of Sewer Use and Drainage Permits by the City and County of Denver for property located at 7210 East Colorado Avenue, Arapahoe County, to provide sanitary sewer and/or wastewater services to property located outside City limits.**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits by the City and County of Denver for property located at 7210 East Colorado Avenue, cannot be issued by the proper officials of the City and County of Denver until after approval action or inaction by the Council of the City in accordance with Subsection 56-97(a)(4) of the Revised Municipal Code of the City, because the Sewer Use and Drainage Permits provide for the carriage of wastewater of a person or entity outside the geographical limits of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has duly reviewed the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permits with respect to property located at 7210 East Colorado Avenue, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the form of Sewer Use and Drainage Permits filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 20200091 are hereby approved.
