10 **WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has
11 found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer requires the
12 easement in the area hereinafter described, and subject to approval by ordinance, has relinquished
13 the same;

14 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

15 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of Public Works in relinquishing the
16 easement reserved in Ordinance No. 20170391, Series of 2017, in the following area:

18 A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 4
19 SOUTH, RANGE 68 WEST OF THE 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, CITY AND COUNTY OF
20 DENVER, STATE OF COLORADO BEING THE 20 FOOT WIDE ALLEY WITHIN BLOCK 12 OF
21 SUMNER'S ADDITION TO DENVER FILED FOR RECORD MAY 21, 1872 DULY RECORDED IN
22 ARAPAHOE COUNTY BOOK OF PLATS, PAGE 35
