

## **Committee Consent Agenda**

## **Business, Workforce & Sustainability**

- BR11- Amends the On-Call Environmental Services Professional Services 0560 Agreement with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for DIA and the former Stapleton Airport to add \$600,000, for a new total of \$2,240,000, and extend the term two years to Dec. 31, 2014.
- BR11- Approves a grants agreement with the US Department of Housing and Urban Development FY 11 allocations for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) of \$7,939,513; HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) of \$3,845,109; and Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) of \$1,585,263.

## **Health, Safety, Education & Services**

BR11- Approves a reimbursement from the State of Colorado Judicial 0559 Department in the amount of \$432,086 to Denver County Court for alcohol evaluations on DUI offenders (RC01037-1).

## Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- BR11- Vacates a portion of the platted alley and a portion of one platted lot in the area bounded by Broadway, 20th Street, and Welton in Council District 8.
- BR11- Corrects a language error regarding allowed heights in the ordinance adopting zoning on the property at 5200 Federal in Council District 1.
- RR11- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way at 3459 Ringsby Court 0554 in Council District 9.
- RR11- Grants a revocable permit to encroach into the public right-of-way with new and existing doors, existing alley doors on a dock, stairway, rails, handicap ramp and the building's rear wall at 2601 Walnut in Council

District 9.

RR11- Approves the final plat for C.P. Bedrock Filing No. 3 at Walden Street and Green Valley Ranch Blvd. in Council District 11.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
