6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

This Grant Agreement addresses the second phase of the Scholarship Initiative, which is to build a scholarship fund leveraged by matching funds from nonprofit and private donors designed to incentivize increased scholarship giving in the State of Colorado. These dollars are intended to complement the services offered by student support programs that received funding during the first phase of the Scholarship Initiative, and to expand upon other student support services in the state.

Objective 1: Scholarships: Award eight hundred ninety-five (895) scholarships will be awarded to new and returning postsecondary students from the Denver Public School (DPS) district. Eligible students will receive an average of \$1,400 per need-based scholarship per semester during the spring 2018 and fall 2018 semesters. All students must be attending a Colorado accredited, non-proprietary postsecondary institution.

The City and County of Denver is a partner in this agreement, the Denver Scholarship Foundation will be receiving the funds NOT the City.
