

## Proclamation No. 15-0689

## Celebrating October as Spellbinders® Oral Storytelling Month

**WHEREAS**, in 1988, Spellbinders® was founded in Denver, Colorado by Germaine Dietsch who wanted to build intergenerational communities between children and older adults; and in1997, Spellbinders® became a Colorado non-profit corporation with the goal of establishing storytelling chapters across the country; and

**WHEREAS**, Spellbinders® oral storytellers have shared the art and joy of oral storytelling with 65,000 Colorado students each year; and

**WHEREAS**, Spellbinders® is dedicated to restoring the art of oral storytelling to connect seniors to youth, weaving together the wisdom of diverse cultures throughout time; and

**WHEREAS**, Spellbinders® oral storytellers are volunteers who embrace the power of stories keeping children spellbound with literature; today, there are 18 chapters in six states and in Canada; and

WHEREAS, Spellbinders® oral storytellers are committed to enhancing literacy, encouraging character development, providing humor, building resources of wisdom, and sharing a love for the written word; and

**WHEREAS**, Spellbinders® gathered at Denver Union Station on October 2, 2015 at 4:25 pm through October 3, 2015 at 5:25 pm, to set the world record of "25 Hours of Storytelling".

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

**Section 1.** That the Denver City Council proclaims the month of October 2015 as Spellbinders® Oral Storytelling Month.
