The Department of Public Safety continues to use Nicoletti Flater Professional Limited Liability Partnership services for employee, spouse, and/or family mental health services due to their familiarity in emergency services and the mental health needs of the first responder community due to continuous exposure to trauma, abnormal work shifts/hours, and work-related stressors.

In addition to limited individual or limited family mental health services, Nicoletti Flater provides consultation services for critical incidents (i.e., officer involved shootings, employee suicide, severe trauma exposure, etc.); required peer support team guidance and oversight; education for professional and uniformed personnel; and 24/7 crisis intervention services.

This request is to extend the term and increase the contract maximum amount to maintain services for our Department of Public Safety employees.
