Scope of work:

CSPV researchers will partner with the Denver ReCast team to collect and report the performance measures required for this project, administer surveys for quality improvement purposes, and build the evaluation capacity of the stakeholders. This will involve administering and collecting the uniform data collection tool of performance measures provided by SAMHSA. CSPV researchers will also develop and administer an annual survey to the advisory board to improve board functioning, and post training surveys appropriate for this project to improve the quality, satisfaction, engagement, and cultural appropriateness of the trainings provided. The data will be collected using REDCap, a secure web platform for managing data. We will work with the Program Administrator to report the performance measures at the required reporting periods. These data will be used to determine whether we are achieving our goals, objectives, and outcomes we intend to achieve and whether adjustments need to be made to the project. For quality improvement purposes (to improve the trainings and board functioning) we will also provide post training and board and survey reports to the appropriate

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stakeholders following the trainings and after the administration of the board survey. Finally, we will provide technical assistance to build evaluation capacity of public and community agency stakeholders. This includes using data for quality improvement and creating a process for stakeholders to understand and use the data to assess project progress, implementation as intended, and to make adjustments as needed.
