EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Belfor Environmental, Inc.

Belfor Environmental, Inc. is an existing contractor for the City who provides on-call labor, equipment and expertise to manage hazardous materials and hazardous wastes. The City calls them for help with chemicals and spills due to criminal activity, highway accidents, and for routine help with the City's chemical wastes. This amendment provides the City with a longer period of coverage, a full five years from 10/2013, and concomitant contract value, to call on this contractor for their critical services.

Having Belfor on contract for three more years allows the City time to solicit competitive bids for new contracts and provides the City with coverage during any anticipated gaps in having others on contract.
