5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance amending Sections 20-18 and 39-224 of the Denver Revised**
7 **Municipal Code to establish a new capital improvement fund series 37000 for**
8 **bond projects and to establish a new capital improvement fund series 36000 to**
9 **receive transfers and appropriate funds for parks, trails and open space capital**
10 **projects, as approved by voters through ballot question 2A in the November**
11 **2018 General Election.**

13 **WHEREAS**, in November of 2018, voters of the City and County of Denver voted approved
14 ballot measure 2A increasing the sales and use tax by a rate of 0.25 percent and dedicating the
15 revenue derived from the tax rate increase to fund Denver parks, trails, and open space projects;

16 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to establish a new capital improvement fund series 36000 for
17 improvements to the Denver parks, trails, and open space projects with such additional tax
18 revenue; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to establish a new capital improvement fund series 37000 for
20 bond projects.

21 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

22 **Section 1.** The fund series number 36000 named bond projects in Section 20-18(6) fund is
23 hereby amended to read as follows:

24 Fund Number: ~~36000~~ 37000

25 Name of fund: Bond projects fund.

26 Source of funds: Proceeds from the sale of bonds, refunds and transfers, gifts and advances,
27 however made, and any other moneys available as may be otherwise provided by law.

28 Purpose of expenditures: Paying the cost of projects or programs as set forth and in accordance
29 with the recitals of bond issuing ordinance or as provided by proposition.

30 Expending authority: The mayor and/or by ordinance.

31 **Section 2.** There is hereby established a new capital fund series number 36000 named the
32 Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital Improvement Fund in Section 20-18(6) of the Denver Revised
33 Municipal Code for the purposes of receiving these transfers and appropriating funds for to parks,
34 trails and open space capital projects. Section 18-20(6) is hereby amended to insert the following:

35 Fund Number: 36000

36 Name of fund: Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital Improvement Fund.

1 Source of funds: Proceeds from the special revenue fund 15828.
2 Purpose of expenditures: Paying the cost of parks, trails, and open space capital improvements.
3 Expending authority: The Executive Director of Parks and Recreation.

4 **Section 3.** Section 39-224 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code concerning the permitted
5 use of revenue in the parks, trails, and open space fund is amended by adding subsection (j). to read
6 as follows:

7 (j). Capital fund series 36000 named the *Parks, Trails, and Open Space Capital*
8 *Improvement Fund* shall be created for the purposes of receiving these transfers and appropriating
9 funds for to parks, trails and open space capital projects.

10 **Section 4.** An annual transfer will occur from the operating special revenue fund (15828) into
11 dedicated capital improvement fund series for parks, trails, and open space capital improvements
12 created herein.



13 **Section 5.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby
14 authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may
15 be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.

16 **Section 6.** This bill is effective upon passage.
