Amends the contract between the City and County of Denver and ShotSpotter, Inc. for approximately 14 miles coverage area in Denver area of ShotSpotter Respond (formerly Flex) Gunfire Detection, Location, Alert and Analysis equipment and services to the Denver Police Department; adds an additional year through 12/31/2021 and adds appropriation of \$835,438 for a contract total of \$4,526,392.

5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

- Contractor provides equipment and services related to high-tech audio equipment, trained acoustic specialists and acoustic analytics capable of classifying outdoor incidents as either gunfire, or other loud sounds not classified as gunfire. For those incidents classified as gunfire, contractor provides pinpoint locations of the gunfire in the service(s) area within 60 seconds.
- Contractor will continue to provide their solution which captures and stores a precise timestamp plus GPS coordinates for each detected incident, as well as each round of a multi-round gunfire incident. This level of detail has successfully been used in investigations and courtrooms to exonerate contentious officer-involved shootings, corroborate testimony, refute false testimony, and prove the presence of multiple shooters in the absence of physical evidence and/or eyewitnesses.
- Contractor will continue to provide for 24/7/365 service for the coverage area for calendar year 2021.

ShotSpotter Respond is a cloud based, subscription managed service with warranty, repair, maintenance, and support services on all of its systems. The ShotSpotter Respond service includes the web-based ShotSpotter Dispatch, ShotSpotter Respond, and ShotSpotter Insight applications which run on any standard browser based platform. This contract amendment will provide continuation of services for the coverage area in Denver for a contract total of \$4,526,392. The proposed term of the contract will be 01/01/2021 – 12/31/2021.
