Proposed ordinance would approve the purchase and sale of an industrial/warehouse property located at 3821-3851 Steele Street (otherwise known as 38th and York). The City is currently the master tenant of the property following a 2007 Settlement Agreement with a borrower who defaulted on an OED loan.

The underlying City leasehold interest contains an Option to Purchase at a set base price which is annually adjusted by CPI. At Closing, the City will exercise its option to purchase the property and immediately sell the Property to 38th Steele Street Properties LLC.
