A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a new Fund in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund Series for the “Climate Protection Capital Projects” program.

WHEREAS, in 2020, Denver voters approved Referred Measure 2A, which increased the sales tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2021 to be spent on various programs and projects that address climate change; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1413, Series of 2020, established the Climate Protection Fund in the General Government Series to receive the sales tax revenue from the incremental increase and to administer the program; and

WHEREAS, an allowable use of revenues for the Climate Protection Program includes capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City requires a new Capital Project Fund to administer climate-related capital projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new Fund is hereby established in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund, Accounting No. 31000, “Climate Protection Capital Projects”, Accounting No. 34804, for the purpose of accounting for various climate-related capital projects.

Section 2. Monies received from transfers from the Climate Protection Fund, transfers from other funds, or other sources of revenue shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 31000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Climate Protection Capital Projects” Fund, Accounting No. 34804, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability and Resiliency. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 34804 include


1 capital improvements, such as planning, design, or construction activities for projects related to
2 climate-action, sustainability, and resiliency. This is an appropriated, non-lapsing fund.

3 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
4 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
5 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
