This contract will increase the capacity of the On-Call Services – Youth Crews contract with Year One-DBA Mile High Youth Corps by \$400,000. This will allow supervised Youth Corps crews to work in Denver Parks. Much of the funding for Youth Corps is from grants. This increase in the contract allows grant funding to be used for Youth Corps as described in the grant applications.
