We are pleased to send out this Letter of Intent regarding the 2019 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program.

Federal funding in support of EMPG for State and local programs has remained steady and continues to provide our partners the opportunity to further develop and improve the emergency management programs for their respective communities. Due to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) timing of the grant cycle, DHSEM should receive the award letter from FEMA sometimes in August 2019. For the 2019 EMPG, each approved jurisdiction should plan to receive an award agreement, barring any unforeseen changes in funding at the Federal level around August. The performance period for the 2019 EMPG grant is January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019.
