- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
 - a. Scope of Work**

The proposed ordinance will allow the City to receive and expend federal funds in the amount of \$1,025,000 for expanding the signal system control by implementing signal system improvements within the City in the area generally bounded by Broadway and Downing St, and 23rd and 40th Avenues, along with S. Monaco Parkway, Leetsdale Dr to Cornell Ave; and Mississippi Ave, Valencia to Dayton Sts. The specific elements of the project include furnishing and installing of system software and equipment, signal equipment (e.g. signal controller cabinets, controllers, etc.), interconnect conduit, communication devices, and communication media. This project is located in Council Districts 4, 5, 6, 8

The proposed ordinance should accomplish two purposes: (1) Authorize receipt of revenue under Charter 3.2.6(e), and (2) Appropriate the funds to the fund/org/project ID.

The CDOT project number is AQC C010-089, the project code (subaccount number) is 17363. This portion of the grant is 100% federally funded up to a maximum of \$1,025,000. This is an on going multi-year program managed by DRCOG and CDOT.

Please note that this is a revised IGA for this TSSIP, MonaCore Traffic Signals project. The original IGA for this project was previously approved by City Council in August of 2009 under the contract control number of RC92030. But due to a change in the contracting language by the Colorado Department of Transportation, this project is now under a new contract control number – RC92055, and it will need to go through the City Council approval process.
