Vendor/Contractor Name: Burst Communications

Contract control number: CE-201204498

Term/Duration of contract/project: 2 years, 9 months (until Dec. 31, 2014)
Construction will complete by late 2012, and the remaining term is to incorporate the term of the equipment/systems maintenance agreements.

Renewal terms: Yes, if project is not completed in timeframe and if City decides to extend maintenance coverage.

Purpose: Design, procurement, installation of video/audio production systems for Denver 8 Media Services. Includes warranties, two years of maintenance coverage, and training of staff on new systems.

Scope of services with performance bench marks: Scope includes timeframes, schedule of construction, and payment schedule. Much of this depends on original manufacturer equipment delivery, which cannot always be guaranteed, so there are no specific bench mark delivery dates.

Cost/value: \$1,168,781.00 which includes professional services and cost of equipment and first two years of maintenance agreements.

Source of funds: Comcast PEG Fee funds, residing in SRF 11706

Benefit: Replaces outdated/failing analog equipment at Denver 8 Media Services, and will result in high-definition digital programming capabilities to match current broadcast and cable TV standards. Plus, this negates the need to move all existing/outdated equipment from Denver 8 Media Services Stapleton facility when we move, resulting in some minor move expense savings.
