5 **Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the city street system, as part**
6 **of the streets listed below, certain real property in Stapleton Filing No. 9.**

8 **WHEREAS**, the Manager of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and
9 determined that the public use, convenience and necessity require the laying out, opening and
10 establishing as public streets designated as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality
11 those portions of real property hereinafter more particularly described, and, subject to approval by
12 resolution has laid out, opened and established the same as the public streets listed below;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
14 **DENVER:**

16 **Section 1.** That the action of the Manager of Public Works in laying out, opening and
17 establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality the following described
18 portions of real property situate, lying and being in the City and County of Denver, State of
19 Colorado, to wit:

- (1) Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., from Quebec St. east to (approximately 800 feet east of
Beeler St.) the east Boundary line of Stapleton filing No. 9, the land in the following
described area:

Tract A, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

- (2) Trenton St., from 29th Ave. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the
following described area:

Tract E, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

- (3) 29th Pl., from Trenton St. east to Ulster St., the land in the following described area:

Tract F, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

- (4) Ulster St., from 29th Ave. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.,
the land in the following described area:

Tract G, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

- (5) 29th Pl., from Ulster St. east to Uinta St., the land in the following described
area:

Tract H, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(6) 29th Pl., from Uinta St. east to Central Park Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract K, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(7) Central Park Blvd., from the south boundary line of Stapleton Filing No. 9, north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract L, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(8) 29th Pl., from Central Park Blvd. east to Willow St., the land in the following described area:

Tract N, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(9) Willow St., from 29th Pl. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract P, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(10) Xenia St., from 29th Pl. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract Q, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(11) Akron Ct., from 29th Pl. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract R, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(12) Alton Ct., from 29th Pl. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract S, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(13) Beeler St., from 29th Pl. north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract T, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

be and the same is hereby approved and said portions of real property are hereby laid out and established and declared laid out, opened and established as part of the above listed streets in Stapleton Filing No. 9.

Section 2. That the real property described in Section 1 hereof shall henceforth be part of the above listed streets in Stapleton Filing No. 9.
