5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

The city has received JUUL/vaping settlement revenue is also expecting funds from the Altria settlement related to a nationwide, youth vaping lawsuit. Denver anticipates receiving approximately \$2.2M in settlement funds over the course of the next four years. This amendment request is to update the Tobacco Sting Special Revenue Fund name and purpose to include all nicotine products (including vaping), as well as to expand the allowable revenue and expenditures in the SRF.

This bill request seeks to amend the title of Ordinance 4587, series of 2001 as follows:

For an ordinance establishing a "~~Tobacco~~ Comprehensive Nicotine Control" fund in the Health Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures from such fund.

Section 1. is amended as follows:

There is hereby established in the Health Special Revenue Fund, Auditor's No. 14000, a "~~Tobacco~~ Comprehensive Nicotine Control" fund, Auditor's No. 14804-6500000, for the purpose of conducting ~~tobacco~~ nicotine prevention, education, cessation, compliance, mitigation and related activities, with a focus, not exclusively, on youth and young adults.

Section 2. is amended as follows:

Monies received from contributions, donations, project incomes, nicotine-related settlements, or other source of private receipts shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 14000 which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3 is amended as follows:

Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Comprehensive Nicotine Control" fund, Auditor's No. 14804-6500000, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Manager of Environmental Health.
