Project Summary

Location: 4055 Albion (near 40th and Colorado Blvd)

Just south of the Colorado Blvd future Light Rail Station

Site: Current undeveloped

Developer: Joe DelZotto – Del West Capital LLC

Joseph DelZotto has been involved in the development and completion of more than 1,800 homes in Colorado since moving from Toronto to Denver about 25 years ago. The DelZotto family has been involved in the construction business since 1934, when Jack DelZotto, a stone mason from Northern Italy migrated with his family to Canada. By the 1950s, Jack's three sons had begun development of subdivisions and apartment buildings. The DelZotto family has built more than 60,000 homes in North America and continues to be based in Toronto, Canada. It should be noted that Joe DelZotto has no prior experience in developing or owning affordable rental housing.

Kensington Townhomes (Aurora) – 154 townhomes – completed 2003

The Lodge at Terralago (Thornton) – 240 condominiums - completed 2005

The Villas at Terralogo (Thornton) - 94 patio homes - completed 2006

The Village at Horseshoe Creek (Granby) – 24 luxury townhomes – completed 2007

Black Feather at Metzler Ranch (Castle Rock) - 160 condominiums - completed 2006

Park Hill Retail (Denver) - site at 40th and Colorado where Starbucks, KTs BBQ, and Carl's Jr

Park Hill Townhomes (Denver) 144 condominiums + 28 townhomes - completed 2009

Proposed Development: Development of 156 affordable rental units serving households at 50% and 60% AMI, comprised of 65 one bedroom units, 83 two-bedroom units and 8 three-bedroom units. The land is owned by Urban Land Conservancy currently and will be leased to the developer. Additionally, Mr. DelZotto has acquired control of land adjacent to this site and intends to develop approximately 146 units apartments on it, see attached diagram. Directly to the west of this proposed development is a small retail shop area with Starbuck's, Carl's Jr and KTs BBQ.
