7 **For an ordinance amending Section 2-53 of the Revised Municipal Code to**  
8 **increase eligibility for appointment to the Denver Board of Ethics.**

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

11 **Section 1.** That section 2-53, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by adding the language underlined,  
12 to read as follows:

13 (b) Qualifications.

14 (1) One and only one member of the board of ethics shall be an officer or employee of the  
15 city. For the purposes of this section, an officer or employee of the city shall not include:

16 (A) A former judicial officer who temporarily performs judicial duties of the County  
17 Court of the City and County of Denver;

18 (B) An election judge as defined in C.R.S., §1-6-101(1).
