The **Denver Sheriff Department (DSD)** seeks approval to implement a comprehensive telephone, tablet and video visitation solution for its detention facilities. This initiative will enhance secure and equitable communication for individuals in custody while improving operational efficiency and supporting community needs.

The proposed solution includes installing and maintaining telephones, kiosks, tablets, and Wi-Fi infrastructure, along with secure video and telephone visitation platforms. It will incorporate fraud prevention tools, digital mail processing, educational and career resources, and business intelligence reporting. Security and compliance measures will ensure legal and operational standards are met, while regular system updates and equipment replacements will be provided at no cost to the City. This investment will improve communication access, enhance security, and support rehabilitation efforts while ensuring long-term system reliability.
