

# Parks and Recreation – Mountain Parks On-Call Forest Health/Planning Services Fact Sheet

## Department of Parks and Recreation - Mountain Parks

The City and County of Denver – Mountain Parks Division is seeking qualified contractors for oncall contract services related to forest health and forest planning services

## Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of these on-call contracts are to establish and maintain a pool of qualified on-call Forest Planning Services and Forest Health Services.

Services include timber stand improvement and forest fuels reduction. Work may also include forest logging operations, which can be comprised of tree cutting, skidding and removal of material and slash management for the purposes of fire mitigation, forest health and ecosystem resiliency. Services may also include forest management planning, as well as prescribed fire planning and management.

#### **Procurement:**

Firms were allowed to submit for their choice of both areas of focus or only one area of focus. Six (6) firms submitted qualification submittals which were reviewed and scored. All six (6) firms were determined to be qualified to provide services to Denver Mountain Parks.

### **Contracts Description:**

Each contract has a three (3) year term and a capacity of \$1 million. The firms selected for these agreements are listed alphabetically. Firms highlighted in yellow applied and were approved for both Forest Planning and Forest Health services:

- Evergreen Fire Protection District
- FBs Inc. dba P&A Tree Service
- Lisscojan Acres LLC
- Markit! Forestry Management
- Rocky Mountain Ecology
- Root Tree Service

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via task notices on an as needed basis.
