A BILL

For an ordinance amending Ordinance 915, Series of 2025, concerning the “Denver Downtown Development Authority” Fund (11893).

WHEREAS, the “Denver Downtown Development Authority” Fund (11893) was established via Ordinance 915, series of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance wishes to amend the fund type from appropriated to revenue-based; and

WHEREAS, this request is a companion to the annual Long Bill and allows for an administrative action needed to implement the 2026 budget as adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance 915, Series of 2025, is hereby amended as follows:

“Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Denver Downtown Development Authority” Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11893, to be expended by the Chief Financial Officer. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 11893 include operational and administrative expenses in accordance with C.R.S. §§ 31-25-801, et seq., the Amended and Restated Plan of Development for the DDDA, and the Cooperation Agreement. This is an revenue-based ~~appropriated~~, non-lapsing fund. This fund will retain interest earnings.”

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
