This equipment will allow for Denver, as a cooperator to the State of Colorado's Division of Fire Prevention and Control (DFPC) Wildfire Operations, to efficiently assist in the coordination efforts and response to areas of responsibility for which DFPC is responsible for protecting. This includes prevention, detection, and suppression of wildland fires, prescribed fire burns, non-wildland fire emergencies (as authorized), and cooperative projects for resource protection.
