ORDINANCE REQUESTS



- 15 Airline Use & Lease (U&L) amendments adding the minimum wage clause
 - Of the **15** Airline U&L Agreements:
 - 10 are strictly adding the minimum wage language and have no additional changes
 - 5 are adding the minimum wage language and have additional change(s)
- DEN expects to have 8 additional U&L amendments come before Council before the end of the year to add the minimum wage language

AIR SERVICE FAST FACTS



- Total Nonstop International Destinations: 26 destinations in 12 countries
- Annual Passenger Traffic: 64.5 million in 2018
- Average Daily Passengers: Over 183,000 through the 12-months ended
 July 2019
- International Passenger Traffic: Over 3 million through the 12-months ended July 2019
- Heaviest Travel Day on Record: July 19, 2019 @ 227,497 passengers
- Origin and Destination Traffic: 64% through the 12-months ended July 2019
- Connecting traffic: 36% through the 12-months ended July 2019

TYPES OF AIRLINE AGREEMENTS



- Signatory Carriers
 - Most airlines have a signed Use and Lease Agreement with the City
 - These airlines have committed to DEN for the term of their lease
- Non-Signatory Carriers
 - They have an airport issued Operating Permit, but have no commitment to DEN
 - Non-signatory carriers pay roughly 20% more
- Space and building leases
 - These leases are separate and not included in the standard Use and Lease Agreements
 - Used for hangars, kitchens, and other facilities outside the terminal complex

U&L SIGNATORY REQUIREMENTS



- Domestic Carriers¹:
 - Lease at least 1 gate; or if the City does not make a gate available, lease at least 500 sf of space and operate at least 2 flights per day
 - Be an "affiliate" of a signatory carrier
- Commuter Carriers²:
 - Operate at least 5 flights per day.
- International Carriers³:
 - Must operate on a scheduled or scheduled charter basis

WHAT'S IN A USE AND LEASE AGREEMENT? **DEN**

- Use and Lease Agreements have nearly all the same language
 - Exactly the same language for all 5-year U&L agreements¹:
 - Allowable uses of the airfield and leased space
 - Requirements for efficient use of city assets
 - Rate making methodology
 - Term
 - Requirements for insurance, sureties, etc.
 - Responsibilities for maintenance of facilities
 - Varies:
 - Definition of leased premises: gates, support spaces, ticket counters, etc.

2019 RATES & CHARGES



• Airline revenues represent the recovery of airport costs, and will fluctuate from year to year based upon budgeted expectations. Each rate supports the airport costs associated with a different part of the facility (e.g. landing fees are used to support airfield costs, while terminal complex rental rates support the costs in the Terminal and Concourses A, B and C).

Description	Signatory Rate	Non-Signatory Rate
Landing Fees	\$4.84	\$5.80
Terminal Complex Rental Rate	\$92.52	\$111.02

- Landing Fees (Rate Per 1,000 lbs of max gross allowable landing weight)
- Terminal Complex Rentals (Annual Cost Per Square Foot)

USE AND LEASE AGREEMENTS AT DEN



United Airlines

- Longest commitment to DEN
- Lease expires in 2035
- Original lease signed in 1992
- Contains unique language and provisions

All Other Carriers

- Agreements were created with a 5 year term in 2012
- Amended in 2017 to include two one-year extension options
- DEN will bring the next U&L Agreements to Council for approval
