6 **For an ordinance making rescissions from and appropriations in the General**
7 **Fund.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Excise and Licenses seeks to amend the Denver Revised
10 Municipal Code through companion ordinances CB21-0216 and CB21-0217 to allow for the
11 licensing and operation of retail marijuana hospitality business and marijuana delivery permits, and
12 to update the DRMC in Chapter 6, Article V- Denver Marijuana Code; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Excise and Licenses will require one-time investments to
14 Accela, the software it uses for permits, licenses, and code enforcement, to support the
15 administration of the changes authorized through said companion ordinances; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the new marijuana licenses authorized through the companion ordinances will
17 generate new revenue to the City's General Fund;

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**
