It is requested that the above subject item be placed on the next available Mayor Council Agenda.

This office has investigated the request of Dennis Arbogast, dated May 31, 2017, on behalf of Park Creek Metropolitan District (PCMD) for requesting the above street rename.

This matter has been inspected and has been coordinated with Asset Management; Colorado Department of Transportation [if State Highway]; Comcast; Commission for People with Disabilities; Community Planning & Development – Building Inspections, Planning and Zoning; City Councilperson; Fire Department; Metro Wastewater Reclamation District; Office of Emergency Management; Parks & Recreation; Public Works – DES - Construction Engineering, DES Engineering – Transportation & Wastewater, Survey, Public Works – Policy and Planning; Public Works – Street Maintenance; CenturyLink; Regional Transportation District; Denver Water Department; Xcel Energy, all of whom have indicated their agreement.

As a result of these investigations, it has been determined that there is no objection to renaming this street.

Additionally, more than 75% of the adjacent property owners have signed a petition to rename the street.

Therefore, you are requested to initiate Council action to rename the following area as Moline St.:



Requestor's name: Park Creek Metropolitan District

Description of Proposed Project: Request for an Ordinance to rename a portion of Havana Way, to Moline St. That part of Havana Way beginning at 26th Ave, thence northly approximately 800 feet.

Explanation of why the public right-of-way must be utilized to accomplish the proposed project: The ROW is staying as is, but the ROW street name will be Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd (from Havana Way)



Description

A part of Havana Way as described in Book 7504 at Page 176 in the Clerk and Recorder's Office of the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 3 South, Range 67 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the South Quarter Corner of said Section 26; thence North 89°39'23" East, along the southerly line of said Southeast Quarter of Section 26, a distance of 590.15 feet to the southwest corner of said Havana Way as described in Book 7504 at Page 176 and the **POINT OF BEGINNING**:

thence along the westerly line said Havana Way Right-of-Way as described in Book 7504 at Page 176 the following two (2) courses:

- 1. North 00°17'27" West a distance of 446.04 feet to a point of curve;
- along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 624.10 feet, a central angle of 37°31'25", an arc length of 408.73 feet and whose chord bears North 19°03'09" West a distance of 401.46 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Stapleton Filing No. 40 recorded at Reception Number 2013109191 in said Clerk and Recorder's Office;

thence South 56°55'06" East a distance of 215.91 feet to the easterly line of said Havana Way as described in Book 7504 at Page 176 and a point of non-tangent curve;

thence along said easterly line of Havana Way as described in Book 7504 at Page 176 the following two (2) courses:

- 1. along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 724.10 feet, a central angle of 21°09'30", an arc length of 267.40 feet and whose chord bears South 10°52'12" East a distance of 265.88 feet;
- 2. South 00°17'27" East a distance of 445.95 feet to said southerly line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26;

thence South 89°39'23" West, along said southerly line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, a distance of 100.00 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.
