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- Section 1. Section 53-4(a) of the Revised Municipal Code is amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:
- Collection methods. To collect on past due fines, debts, or fees, or dishonored bank drafts and other negotiable instruments, the city may employ any collection method available, including assigning such accounts to private counsel or private collection agencies. In order to collect delinquent fines, debts, or fees, or dishonored bank drafts and other negotiable instruments, the city may, at its option, sue the debtor in the second judicial district any court of competent jurisdiction. If suit is brought, then reasonable collection costs, attorney's fees, and legal expenses shall be added to the amount due. In the case of dishonored bank drafts and other negotiable instruments, in addition to the fee provided for in section 53-3, the city may pursue all remedies provided for in the Colorado Revised Statutes.
