The purpose of the amendment is to extend the term of this General Engineering Services Master On-Call Agreement by one year, through January 14, 2021. Capacity of the contract will be increased from \$4 million to \$6 million dollars.

The benefit of this extension is to provide a continuity of service, coordination, close-out, and audit of open task orders that support the Public Works Capital Program and Infrastructure needs. The additional time will ensure continuation of services while we are assessing the number of contracts needed for the anticipated workload
