6 **For an ordinance to change the Fund and expending authority for the “Law**  
7 **Enforcement Assisted Diversion Grant” program from the Public Health Fund**  
8 **Series under the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment to the**  
9 **Public Safety Special Revenue Fund Series under the Executive Director of**  
10 **Safety.**

12 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 765, Series of 2020, approved the “Law Enforcement Assisted  
13 Diversion Grant” program under the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE)  
14 expending authority in the Public Health Fund Series, Special Revenue Fund No. 14000; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the original grant agreement was subsequently amended to increase the award  
16 amount to \$1,683,375 and extend the term through June 30, 2023; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the LEAD Grant aims to divert individuals to immediate service in lieu of the  
18 traditional criminal justice pathway by partnering with key stakeholder partners and is administered  
19 under the Crime Prevention and Control Committee (CPCC) which resided under DDPHE; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in 2022 the CPCC moved to the Executive Director of Safety along with other  
21 diversion programs that are in alignment with the LEAD Grant; and

22 **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes a change in fund and expending authority for the LEAD  
23 Grant program;

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**  
26 **OF DENVER:**

28 **Section 1.** The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the  
29 “Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion Grant” Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the  
30 City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section  
31 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

32 **Section 2.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said  
33 program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Safety, is as follows:
