FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDATORY AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado (the "City") and MILE HIGH MONTESSORI EARLY LEARNING CENTERS, a Colorado nonprofit corporation, with an address of 616 East Speer Boulevard, Denver, Colorado 80203, (the "Contractor"), jointly "the parties."

RECITALS

A. The Parties entered into an Agreement dated August 22, 2024 (collectively the "Agreement") for the performance of certain work set forth in that Agreement and the exhibits thereto; and

B. The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to increase the maximum contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby amend the Agreement as follows:

1. All references to "Exhibit B" in the existing Agreement shall be amended to read: "Exhibit B and Exhibit B-1, as applicable." The budget document marked as Exhibit B-1 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. Section 7.D. of the Agreement entitled "<u>Maximum Contract Amount</u>" is amended to read as follows:

"(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Agreement, the City's maximum payment obligation will not exceed THREE MILLION SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTEEN CENTS (\$3,069,668.15) (the "Maximum Contract Amount"). The City is not obligated to execute an Agreement or any amendments for any further services, including any services performed by Contractor beyond that specifically described in Exhibit A. Any services performed beyond those in Exhibit A are performed at Contractor's risk and without authorization under the Agreement."

3. Section 7.F. of the Agreement entitled "<u>Non-Federal Share Match</u>" is amended to read as follows:

"The Contractor will contribute a match of at least twenty percent (20%) of the Maximum Contract Amount from non-federal funds through cash or inkind contributions of services or property. Values for non-federal in-kind contributions of services and property will be established in accordance with applicable federal law, regulations, cost principles, or as otherwise determined by an appropriate federal agency. Contractor's total non-federal

match contribution (cash and in-kind services or property) under this Agreement will be at least SIX HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS AND SIXTY-THREE CENTS (\$613,933.63) as set forth in more detail in Exhibit A. The Contractor will report in writing to the City, within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of receipt thereof, any cash or other funds to be applied toward the non-federal match that Contractor receives. Contractor will be responsible for documenting and maintaining accurate records to the reasonable satisfaction of the City of both Contractors' non-federal share contributions and the contributions of Subdelegates and any Vendor designated by the Director. Such contributions will be recorded on each expenditure variance report and in written reports forwarded to the City on a monthly basis. Each monthly report will list all contributions provided by Contractor and/or its Subdelegates and/or any Vendor for each respective quarter and will list the total amount of contributions made as of the date of the monthly report."

4. Except as herein amended, the Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every particular.

5. This First Amendatory Agreement will not be effective or binding on the City until it has been fully executed by all required signatories of the City and County of Denver, and if required by Charter, approved by the City Council.
