OED: CDBG & HOPWA Program

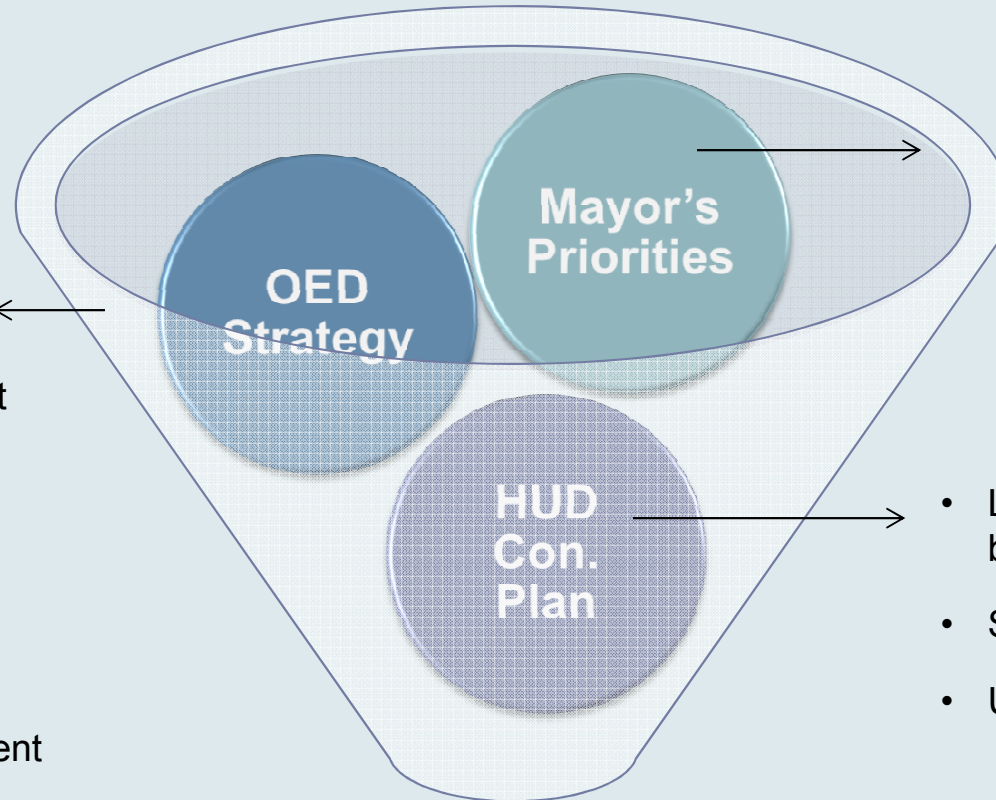

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
Annual grant to large cities and urban counties to provide housing, a suitable living environment, and opportunities to expand economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons
- HOPWA (Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS)
A formula grant used for housing development, social services, facility operations, rental assistance, health care and mental health services

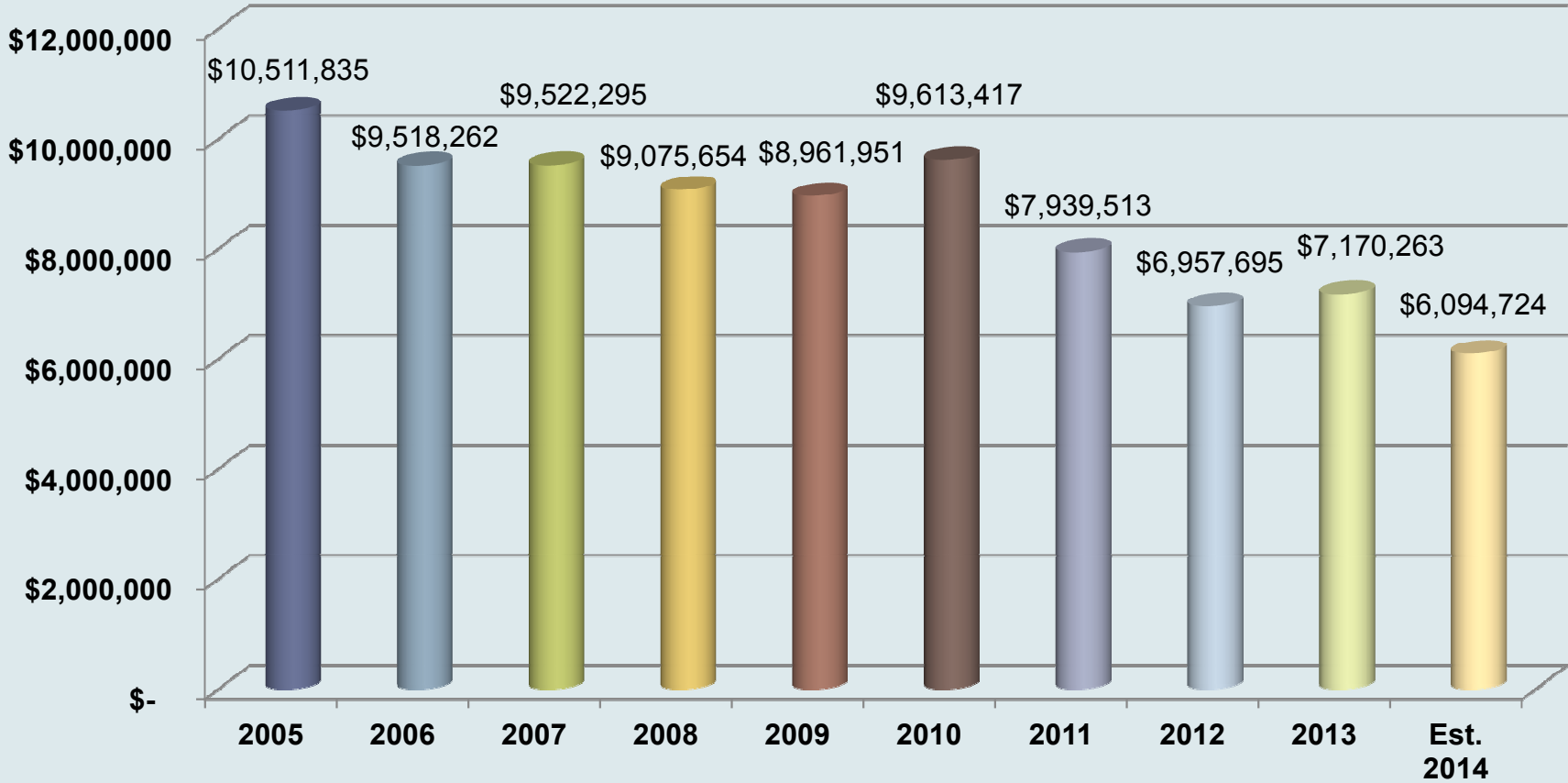

OED HOPWA Programs

- Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) & Project Based Rental Assistance (PBRA)
 - Rental subsidy programs that allows tenant to secure a unit wherever a landlord will accept the voucher.
- Short Term Rent Mortgage Utility assistance (STRMU)
 - Program to prevent eviction and foreclosure
- Permanent Housing Placement (PHP)
 - Move-in deposit assistance program
- Supportive Services
 - case management provided to individuals who access direct assistance (TBRA, PBRA, STRMU or PHP)
