## **1. Parties**

This Amendment (the “Amendment”) to the Original Agreement shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment (The “Agreement”) is entered into by and between the Grantee, and the State.

## **2. Terminology**

Except as specifically modified by the Amendment, all terms used in this Amendment shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment (the “Agreement”) is entered into by and between the Grantee, and the State

## **3. Amendment Effective Date and Term**

### **A. Amendment Effective Date**

This Amendment shall not be valid or enforceable until the Amendment Effective Date shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment. The State shall not be bound by any provision of this Amendment before that Amendment Effective Date, and shall have no obligation to pay Grantee for any Work performed or expense incurred under this Amendment either before or after of the Amendment term shown in **§3.B** of this Amendment.

### **B. Amendment Term**

The Parties’ respective performances under this Amendment and the changes to the Agreement contained herein shall commence on the Amendment Effective Date shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment or September 22, 2026, whichever is later and shall terminate on the termination of the Agreement.

## **4. Purpose**

This amendment is to add language to the Additional Provisions exhibit to allow modification of quantities with an Option Letter, and to modify Exhibit C, Budget of the Original Agreement.

## **5. Modification**

The Agreement and all prior amendments thereto, if any, are modified as follows:

- A. The Agreement Maximum Amount field on the Agreement’s Signature and Cover Page is hereby deleted and replaced with the Current Agreement Maximum Amount field shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment.

- B. The Parties now agree to modify Exhibit A, Additional Provisions of the Original Contract to include the following: V. Option to Increase or Decrease Maximum Amount. The State has the Option to increase or decrease the statewide quantity of Goods and Services based upon the rates established in this Contract, and increase or decrease the maximum amount payable accordingly. In order to exercise this option, the State shall provide written notice to Contractor in a form substantially equivalent to the Sample Option Letter attached to this Contract. Delivery of Goods and performance of Services shall continue at the same rates and terms as described in this Contract. The State may include and incorporate a revised budget with the option letter, as long as the revised budget does not unilaterally change rates or terms specified in this Contract.
- C. The Parties now agree to modify Exhibit C, Budget of the original agreement. Exhibit C, Budget is deleted and replaced in its entirety with Exhibit C, Budget attached to this Amendment.

#### **6. Limits of Effect and Order of Precedence**

This Amendment is incorporated by reference into the Agreement, and the Agreement and all prior amendments or other modifications to the Agreement, if any, remain in full force and effect except as specifically modified in this Amendment Except for the Special Provisions contained in the Agreement, in the event of any conflict, inconsistency, variance, or contradiction between the provisions of this Amendment and any of the provisions of the Agreement or any prior modification to the Agreement, the provisions of this Amendment shall in all respects supersede, govern, and control. The provisions of this Amendment shall only supersede, govern, and control over the Special Provisions contained in the Agreement to the extent that this Amendment specifically modifies those Special Provisions.
